COOKING SKILLS

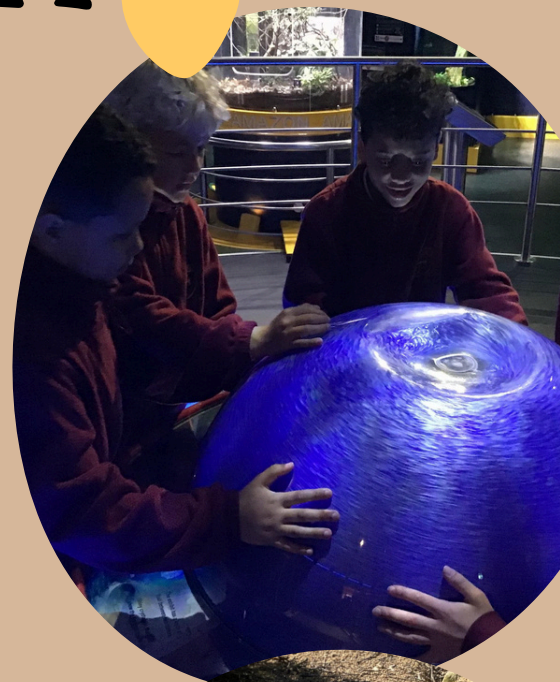
Year 5 proved to be great cooks in their DT project work. They worked hard to plan, prep and make soup. It truly was delicious!

Yr1 – School Days

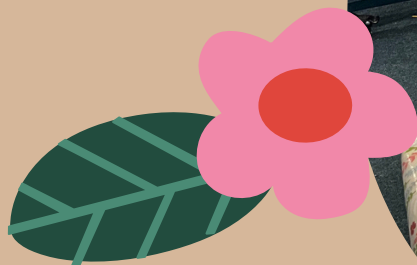
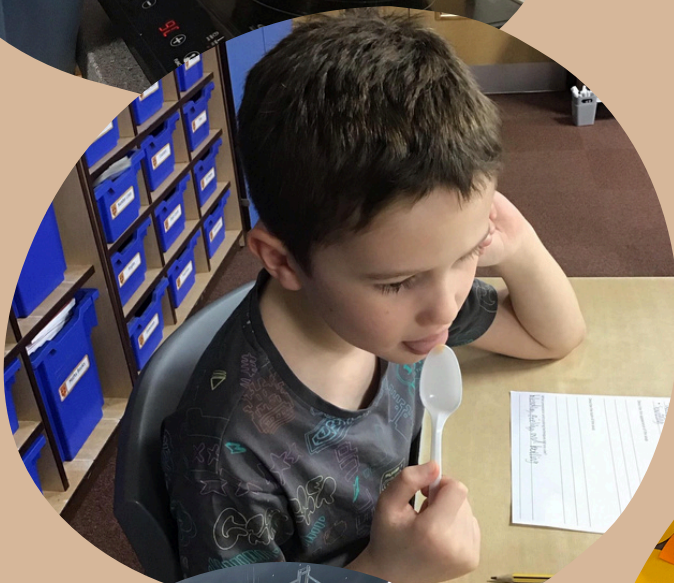
